Czech Airlines Technics to provide services to Eurowings and Bees Airline

Czech Airlines Technics (CSAT) has expanded its customer portfolio. Eurowings, German air carrier, that launched operations of its base at Václav Havel Airport Prague last November, now uses CSAT line maintenance services for its Airbus A320ceo and A320neo family aircraft based in Prague. Another carrier, Bees Airline, that has been operating its flights between Prague and Ukraine since October 2021, has ordered CSAT on-call line maintenance services for its Boeing 737-800 planes. Prague Airport handled nearly 4.4 million passengers in 2021

Last year, the Prague Airport handled a total of 4,388,826 passengers, 20 percent more than in 2020. However, it still represents a drop of about 75 percent compared to the year 2019. Throughout 2021, **outbound tourism** was predominant. The greatest number of passengers flew from Prague to Spain, Greece, and Italy. Amsterdam, Paris, and London were the most frequented among the cities connected with Prague by direct flights. More at <u>www.prg.aero/en</u>.

Smartwings carried over 2.7 million passengers last year

Last year, Smartwings carried more than 2.5 million (2,529,611) passengers on scheduled and charter flights, a yearon-year increase of 199%. The company carried another 159,000 passengers on board its aircraft on flights for other carriers: more than 2.7 million passengers (2,716,299) used the services of Smartwings in the Czech Republic and abroad last year. Most passengers, 1.55 million, were carried by Smartwings from/to the Czech Republic (+ 221.5%), and over 981 thousand passengers on flights operated from the carrier's foreign bases. In addition to the Czech Republic, Smartwings operated flights from airports in Poland, France, Germany, Israel, Hungary, Slovakia and the Canary Islands. Source: Smartwings.

Tourist fee for stay in Prague increased

Since the beginning of this year, **tourists in Prague pay a higher stay fee**. By increasing the fee from CZK 21 to **CZK 50**, Prague will receive funds needed to fulfill its long-term vision of cultivated and sustainable tourism, the development of the city as an attractive destination for congresses, conferences or exhibitions and for promotion of the city abroad. 
Jindra Čapek's World of fantasy
