Pytloun Hotels opened new Old **Armory Prague restaurant near** Kampa Park



The Czech hotel chain Pytloun Hotels opened a new restaurant, Old Armory Prague, on the ground floor of the Pytloun Old Armory Prague hotel, which is part of the chain since last October. The hotel with restaurant is located in a building from the 17th century in the beautiful surroundings of Prague's Lesser Town, next to Kampa Park not far from the Charles Bridge. The restaurant is open from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. for **breakfast** served in the form of a rich hot and cold buffet, which can also be enjoyed by those who do not live in the hotel. The restaurant is closed during lunch. Dinner is served from 18:00 to 22:00 and the restaurant is **open until 23:00**. The restaurant's terrace is accessible via a bridge directly from Kampa and offers unique opportunity to enjoy local cuisine with a view of the romantic Kampa park. Data & Research

Almost 6 million tourists came to Prague in 2022

According to data from the Czech Statistical Office, 5,976,267 travelers arrived in Prague last year. Up to one quarter of them were Czech tourists, whose attendance increased by more than 20% compared to 2019. After previous years marked by pandemics, tourists from Asian countries slowly began to return to the Czech capital, their number increased by almost 400% compared to 2021. Most Asian travelers last year came from South Korea (47,416) and India (40,886). However, the numbers are still at less than 25% of the year 2019, when more than a million Asian tourists came to Prague. Source: Prague City Tourism

In 2022, the Vysočina region saw the highest number of tourists over the last ten years.



646,772 tourists visited the Vysočina region last year, 40,000 more than in the most successful year of 2019. According to the Czech Statistical Office, 576,000 Czech tourists visited Vysočina in 2022. Foreign visitors are also returning, their numbers increased by half to 71 thousand compared to the previous year. Among foreign tourists, visitors from Slovakia, Germany and Poland are the most numerous. Source: Vysočina Tourism

The Krkonoše National Park celebrates 60th anniversary



On Wednesday, May 17, 2023, 60 years will pass since the establishment of the Krkonoše National Park located in the Czech Republic's two regions, the Hradec Králové and Liberec region. Celebrations of the anniversary will take place throughout the year. The main event will come on Friday, May 19 in the town of Vrchlabí, where a series of afternoon concerts will be topped with a video mapping illustrating the history of the park projected onto the southern facade of the former Augustinian monastery, the future KRNAP Visitor Center. Equinox in the Cathedral of the **Assumption of the Virgin Mary in** Sedlec near Kutná Hora



The Cathedral of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary, like many other sacred buildings, is oriented with the entrance to the west and the main altar to the east. The builders of the cathedral in the 13th century very precisely determined the axis of the sunset to the floor plan of the building and built the Sedlec temple in a way that allows a ray of the setting sun on the days of the spring and autumn equinoxes to fall through the largest window in the western facade of the cathedral directly **onto the main** altar. Easter in the Central Bohemia

At the **Konopiště castle**, the Museum of St George prepares a beautiful Easter decoration that also includes Jesus riding a donkey. Two unique processional figures of Jesus riding a donkey, which were carried in the liturgical procession on Palm Sunday to commemorate Jesus' famous entry into Jerusalem, have been preserved in the castle fund of the Konopiště castle. Easter celebrations in the Vysoký Chlumec **open-air museum** will offer examples of traditional customs in the authentic environment of rural cottages, and in the Mining Museum in **Příbram**, visitors will be reminded of how the most important Christian holiday, Easter, was celebrated by the miners at the turn of the 19th and 20th centuries.

Opening of the spa season



Every year in May, the season in Czech spas officially begins. In Karlovy Vary, the opening will take place on **May 5-7**. As every year, the three-day

program will include, for example, the blessing of the springs and a solemn mass, the procession of the entourage of Charles IV. or a craft market with period attractions for children free of charge. In Mariánské Lázně, the opening of the season traditionally falls on the **second weekend of May**, from the 12th to the 14th. The celebrations include the consecration of the springs, a festive parade, a concert by the West Bohemian Symphony Orchestra, mass and a rich accompanying program. On May 20, the town of Františkovy Lázně will start its 230th spa season, in **Teplice** the spa season will start on May 26-28, in Luhačovice on May 12-14, in Poděbrady on May 13, in Jáchymov on May 27. and Lázně **Bělohrad** will open the season on **May** 20. Konstantinovy Lázně will also offer a rich cultural program on May 19-21, including a vintage car ride and a promenade concert.

Renovated Bohemia Restaurant to offer unique facilities for events



The former **Bohemia restaurant** at the **Prague Exhibition Grounds** has undergone a complete and very demanding reconstruction. The building of the former Pilsen restaurant from 1891 now opens its doors to the public, and it will serve for various purposes

such as **conferences**, exhibitions, fashion shows, chamber music concerts and other cultural events and social or business meetings. The Bohemia building was originally built as a restaurant for the Jubilee Exhibition in 1891, making it one of the oldest buildings at the Exhibition Grounds. The building offers a spacious ground floor hall and two lounges on the upper floor. There is also a kitchen equipped with top technology for the most demanding catering services. AITF Baku 2023



Czechia is returning to the **AIFT** trade fair in Baku, Azerbaijan, which will be held on April 4-6, 2023, after a covid break with a **shared stand**. Czechia is traditionally perceived here as a spa destination. Due to the great interest of exhibitors in participating in the fair, area of the Czech exposition had to be expanded, and now 6 Czech partners from the spa industry will also participate in the fair.

IWINETC – International Wine **Tourism Conference**



Czechia and its wines will be presented for the first time at the international conference on wine tourism, which will be held in Tarragona, Spain on March 23 and 24, 2023. The CzechTourism agency, in cooperation with the South Moravian Tourism Center and the National Wine Center, will present Czechia as a destination for wine tourism at the conference. The event has been held annually since 2011 and is mainly attended by tour operators specializing in wine tourism and gastro tourism from all over the world. The name of the Czech contribution to the conference is Czech **Wine Escapes: Where Wine Pairs** with Folklore, Heritage and Design, the contribution will be followed by the Czech Wine Masterclass, which will offer six samples of Czech and Moravian wines for tasting.
